- 1. That part of Main Street extending from Queen Street to Nelson Street is hereby closed to vehicular traffic from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the 4th day of July, 1981.
- 2. The proposed alternate route for vehicular traffic will route traffic along Queen Street to George Street to Nelson Street subject to any variations in the public interest and safety.
- 3. This by-law shall come into force on the use day of July , 1981.
