A by-law to close part of Main Street to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis,

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton desires to close part of Main Street within The City of Brampton for the purpose of assisting in the performance of the Pine & Rose Festival within The City of Brampton;


AND FURTHER WHEREAS the Pine & Rose Festival will be held on the 4th day of July, 1981;


AND FURTHER WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton has power to close part of Main Street to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis pursuant to S. 352-61 of The Municipal Act;

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of Main Street extending from Queen Street to Nelson Street is hereby closed to vehicular traffic from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the 4th day of July, 1981.
2. The proposed alternate route for vehicular traffic will route traffic along Queen Street to George Street to Nelson Street subject to any variations in the public interest and safety.
3. This by-law shall come into force on the *4th* day of *July*, 1981.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of *June*, 1981.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of June, 1981.


