



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 142-96

To Change the name of Precisioncraft Court
and to repeal By-law 126-94

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton established the lands described in Schedule A to this By-law as part of the public highway system, to be known as Bramtrail Court, by By-law 289-89 registered as Instrument No. LT1079341.

By By-law 126-94 registered as Instrument no. LT1511051, the name of Bramtrail Court was changed to Precisioncraft Court.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is expedient to change the name of Precisioncraft Court to Precidio Court.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of Precisioncraft Court (formerly Bramtrail Court), being composed of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law, is hereby changed to Precidio Court.
2. By-law 126-94 is hereby repealed.
3. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B forms part of this by-law.




1. A public notice respecting the street name change of Precisioncraft Court was advertised in the Brampton Guardian on the following dates:
