BY-LAW

Number 144-89

A By-law to amend By-law 31-81
as amended, which regulates
animals other than dogs

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS
FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 31-81, as amended by By-laws 260-83, 203-84 and 301-84, is hereby further amended by deleting section 9 thereof, and substituting thereof, and substituting therefor the following:
 - "9. (1) Except as permitted by sections 9(2), 12 and 13, no person shall keep, or permit to be kept, more than two pigeons, more than two rabbits, more than two domestic fowl or more than two game fowl on the premises of or in a dwelling unit located on land the use of which is restricted to residential purposes and which is within a registered plan of subdivision or a built-up urban area.
 - (2) The offspring of the animals permitted to be kept by subsection 9(1) may be kept on the same premises for up to 3 months after their births."
2. By-laws 203-84 and 301-84 are repealed.
