To declare surplus and
authorize the sale of
part of Block 251, Plan 43M-1303

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that part of Block 251, Registered Plan 43M-1303, City of Brampton, designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-28731 (the "Lands") be sold to the Region of Peel for road-widening purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Lands were conveyed to the City for nominal consideration and the City no longer requires the Lands and has agreed to convey the Lands;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Part of Block 251, Registered Plan 43M-1303 designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-28731 is hereby declared to be surplus.
2. The transfer for nominal consideration of Part of Block 251, Registered Plan 43M-1303 designated as Part 1 on Plan 43R-28731 to the Region of Peel is hereby authorized, and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments that in the opinion of the City Solicitor may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 26th day of May, 2004.
