To authorize surplus lands and transfer to the original transferor

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City reconvey Lots 25, 26 and 27 and Block 121, Plan 43M-1578 (the "Lands") to the original transferor of the Lands (the "Developer") to the City;

**AND WHEREAS** the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The reconveyance of the Lands for nominal consideration to the Developer is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of the said lands.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this  $26^{th}$  day of May, 2004.
