	To prevent the application o of Registered Plan 43M-811		-	of part lot control to part	

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

- Subsection 5 of section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, does not apply to the following lands:
 City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:
 - the whole of Blocks 3, 4, 8, 10, and 11, on Registered Plan 43M-811
 - the remainder of Parcel Block 5-1, Section 43M-811, being part of Block 5, on Registered Plan 43M-811, and the remainder of Parcel Block 9-1 and the whole of Parcel Block 9-2, Section 43M-811, being all of Block 9 on Registered Plan 43M-811
 - Peel Condominium Plan 408 (formerly the whole of Block 6 on Registered Plan 43M-811)
 - Peel Condominium Plan 451 (formerly the whole of Block 7 on Registered Plan 43M-811)
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by The Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of July, 1995.
