To prevent the application of part lot control to certain lands (Lots 1, 26, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 34 and 122, R.P. 43M-441)

WHEREAS subsection 29(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 379, as amended) has imposed part lot control on all registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 29(10) of the <u>Planning</u>

<u>Act</u>, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that
part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered
plans as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Subsection 5 of section 29 of the <u>Planning Act</u> does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A attached hereto.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by The Regional Municipality of Peel.
