Number 151-2002

To authorize the execution
of an agreement under section 30
of the Expropriations Act with
Main street South Limited

WHEREAS Brampton City Council at its meeting of December 12, 2001 enacted By-law 360-2001 to authorize the application for approval to expropriate the southerly 2 acres, more or less of the property located at the south-west corner of Ray Lawson Boulevard and Hurontario Street, together with and subject to necessary easements for utilities, access and parking for the purposes of a Provincial Offences Court facility;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton and the landowner Main Street Village South Limited, have agreed to enter into an agreement pursuant to section 30 of the Expropriations Act setting out the terms and conditions related to the acquisition of the necessary lands by the City;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**



The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement dated the 27th day of May, 2002 pursuant to section 30 of the Expropriations Act between Main Street Village South Limited and The Corporation of the City of Brampton relating to the acquisition by the City of the southerly 2 acres together with and subject to necessary easements for access, parking and servicing, of the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 27th day of May, 2002.
