BY-LAW

Number 152-2002

To authorize the acquisition of the property known municipally as 10501 Bramalea Road

WHEREAS City Council enacted By-law 2-2002 to authorize the expropriation of certain lands for the purpose of extending Sandalwood Parkway East and widening Bramalea Road, including the lands owned by Donna Clarkson Turner described as Part of Lot 13, Concession 5 East of Hurontario Street designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-25561;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton and Donna Turner have reached an agreement on compensation for the acquisition of the Turner property by the City;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The acquisition of the Part of Lot 13, Concession 5 East of Hurontario Street designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Plan 43R-25561 for the purposes of extending Sandalwood Parkway East and widening Bramalea Road is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents, including an agreement under section 30 of the Expropriations Act, approved by the City Solicitor, that in his opinion are necessary to effect the acquisition of the subject lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 27th day of May, 2002.
