BY-LAW

Number 158-2008

To declare surplus and authorize the Transfer of easement over Part of Lot 5, Concession 10 ND Being Parts 26, 50 and 74 on Plan 43R-32167, Brampton

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a transfer of easement over Part of Lot 5, Concession 10 Northern Division, Designated as Parts 26, 50 and 74 on Plan 43R-32167 (the "Lands") to be conveyed to The Regional Municipality of Peel (the "Region").

AND WHEREAS the Lands were conveyed for valley land purposes and road widening purposes to the City for nominal consideration through the development of Part of Lot 5, Concession 10ND designated as Parts 1 to 23, both inclusive and Parts 26 to 30, both inclusive on Reference Plan 43R-24972 and Part 14 on Reference Plan 43R-24045, and the Region now requires two easements over the Lands for sanitary sewer purposes and right-of-way purposes.

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by By-Law No. 98-2005 have been followed:

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby **ENACTS** as follows:

- 1. The two transfer of easements for nominal consideration over the Lands in favour of the Region is hereby authorized; and,
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to effect the two transfers of easements over the Lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 25th day of June, 2008.
