



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 159-2005

To authorize the purchase of
certain lands for the purpose of
road widening

Section 6 of the *Municipal Act 2001* authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The purchase of the lands described as that part of Lot 11 Concession 9, Northern Division, in the City of Brampton, designated as Parts 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 on Reference Plan 43R-29142 and that Part of Lot 11 Concession 9, Northern Division, City of Brampton designated as Parts 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 on Reference Plan 43R-29142 for the purposes of road widening, is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between vendor, Thomas Joseph Fitzpatrick, Ralph Fitzpatrick and John Fitzpatrick as to the first property described above and Kathleen Mary Fitzpatrick, Sandra Earleen Fitzpatrick, Thomas Joseph Fitzpatrick, John Fitzpatrick and Ralph Fitzpatrick as to the second property described above and purchaser, The Corporation of the City of Brampton, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said land.
3. The funds for the acquisition shall be taken from capital project account #034030

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 25 day of May, 2005.
