THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON BY-LAW NUMBER 160-75

A By-law to authorize the execution of an Agreement between Industrial Steam Limited, Goldfan Holdings Limited, Toronto-Dominion Bank, Regional Municipality of Peel and the Corporation of the City of Brampton.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement between Industrial Steam Limited, Goldfan Holdings Limited, Toronto-Dominion Bank, Regional Municipality of Peel, and the Corporation of the City of Brampton, in the form annexed hereto.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 25th day of August, 1975.

THIS AGREEMENT made this 22nd day of August, 1975

BETWEEN:

INDUSTRIAL STEAM LIMITED as to an undivided two- thirds (2/3) interest and GOLDFAN HOLDINGS LIMITED as to the remaining one-third (1/3) interest both Corporations duly incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, having their Head Office in the Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, (hereinafter called the "Developer")

OF THE FIRST PART

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THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON (hereinafter called the "City")

OF THE SECOND PART

AND

THE CORPORATION OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF PEEL

(hereinafter called the "Region")

OF THE THIRD PART

A N D

TORONTO DOMINION BANK of the City of Toronto,
in the Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto
(hereinafter called the "First Mortgagee")

OF THE FOURTH PART

WHEREAS an Engineering Agreement was executed on the 27th day of November, 1973 between the Developer and the Town of Mississauga and the Public Utilities Commission of the Town of Mississauga and the Mortgagees affecting lands in a proposed subdivision described in Schedule "Al" to that Agreement.

AND WHEREAS the Regional Municipality of Peel Act 1973 incorporated and established the Region and the City.

AND WHEREAS the lands affected by the said Engineering Agreement which were formerly within the Town of Mississauga are now located in the City of Brampton.

AND WHEREAS the Region is the successor to the Public Utilities Commission of the Town of Mississauga and is also now the authority having jurisdiction with respect to sanitary sewer services to the lands affected by the Engineering Agreement and is also the authority having jurisdiction with respect to certain roads abutting the said lands which are now Regional roads.

AND WHEREAS the City is in all other respects the successor to the Town of Mississauga with respect to the provisions of the said Engineering Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of other valuable consideration and the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) of lawful money of Canada now paid by each of the City and the Region to the Developer (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) and in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants herein;

- 1. The parties hereto hereby confirm and agree to be bound by the provisions of the Engineering Agreement recited above which was executed on the 27th day of November, 1973, including all schedules thereto, except insofar as it or the schedules are amended hereby.
- 2. The parties hereto agree that the Engineering Agreement recited above is hereby amended by the addition of the following clauses:
 - The Developer shall enter into such agreements as may be necessary with the proper authority having jurisdiction over hydro services to the lands, with respect to electrical distribution systems and necessary appurtenances to service the lands and such other matters including the payment of levies as the said authority shall require, provided, however, that the electrical distribution system shall be underground. The City shall not be obligated to issue any building permits until provided with confirmation by the authority that the agreements provided for by this clause have been entered into or other satisfactory arrangements have been made.

- (b) That the Developer agrees to obtain a detailed analysis of noise related to the use of Malton Airport, including approaches and departures, and shall insure that the necessary analysis of noise-reduction requirements shall have full regard for the policy statement on the subject released to the public by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on October 9, 1969, relating the requirements to those for lands in noise sensitivity zone IV of that statement and the City shall not be obligated to issue any building permits until provided with confirmation that this condition has been complied with.
- The parties hereby agree that Schedules "B" and "C" to the Engineering Agreement recited above shall be deleted and replaced with the new Schedules "B" and "C" annexed hereto.

- (a) Transfer of One-Foot Reserves to the Regional Municipality of Peel Blocks K, H and E.
- (b) Transfer of One-Foot Reserves to The Corporation of the City of Brampton - Blocks C, D, F, G, I and J.
- (c) Transfer and Grant of Easement to The Corporation of the City of Brampton - Parts of Lots 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 24 and Parts of Block A and B as shown on Plan M-(City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel), registered in the Office of Land Titles at Brampton and designated as Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 10 on a Plan of Survey of Record in the said Office as 43R-
- (d) Transfer and Grant of Easement to the Regional Municipality of Peel - Parts of Lots 11, 12, 24 and Parts of Blocks A and B, as shown on Plan M-(City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel) registered in the Office of Land Titles at Brampton and designated as Parts 3, 4, 5, 8 and 9, on Plan of Survey of Record in the said Office as 43R-
- (e) Transfer and Grant of Easement to The Corporation of the City of Brampton and the owner or owners of Lot 24 from time to time granting access from Lot 24 to Melanie Drive - Parts of Lots 11 and 12, Plan M-(City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel) and designated as Parts 5 and 6 on a Plan of Survey of Record in the said Office as 43R-
- (f) Blocks A and B to be dedicated to the Ministry of Transportation and Communications forming part of the future Highway 407.
- (g) Transfer to the Region of the Fifty-foot daylighting radii at the intersection of Melanie Drive and Steeles Avenue.

- (b). Blocks A and B to be dedicated to the Ministry of Transportation and Communications forming part of the future Highway 407.
- (c). Transfer and Grant of Easement of Parts 5 and 6 as designated in Reference Plan 43R-to The Corporation of the City of Brampton and the owners of Lot 24 from time to time granting access from Lot 24 to Melanie Drive to be used only in the event that the access to Torbram Road from Lot 24 is removed, revised or relocated in accordance with the request of The Corporation of the City of Brampton and/or The Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
