WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ("the City Council") is composed of a Mayor elected by general vote and sixteen (16) members elected by wards, five (5) of which are members of both the City Council and the Council of The Regional Municipality of Peel ("the Regional Council");

AND WHEREAS subsection 29(3) of the Municipal Act (Ontario), as amended ("the Act") provides that the Council may pass a by-law changing the number of its elected members;

AND WHEREAS the City Council wishes to change the number of its elected members from seventeen (17) to eleven (11) effective from the first day of December, 2003;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with subsection 29(7) of the Act, notice of the intention to pass this by-law and notice of a public meeting to consider the matter was published in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of Brampton on the $17^{\rm th}$, $22^{\rm nd}$ and $26^{\rm th}$ days of May, 2002.

AND WHEREAS a public meeting was held on May 27, 2002 and the City Council heard from members of the public in regards to this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The number of elected members of City Council is hereby changed from seventeen (17) to eleven (11) elected members and the City Council shall be composed of:
 - 1.1 a head of Council called the Mayor elected by general vote; and
 - 1.2 five (5) elected members called City Councillors, to be elected by wards in accordance with a by-law to be passed by the City Council, as members of the City Council only; and

- 1.3 five (5) elected members called Regional Councillors, to be elected by wards in accordance with a by-law passed by the City Council, as members of both the City Council and the Regional Council.
- 2. This change in the number of elected members of the City Council shall be effective from the 1st day of December, 2003 and shall apply to and govern the election to be held in 2003 for members of the City Council and the Regional Council who will take office on the 1st day of December, 2003.
- 3. In the event the *Municipal Elections Act (Ontario)*, as amended is further amended to provide for a term of office commencing on a date other than the 1st day of December in an election year, this change in the number of elected members of the City Council shall be effective on the date in the 2003 election year, set out in the amendment for the commencement of the term of office.
- 4. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule A hereto, shall form part of this by-law.
- 5. This by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 10th day of June, 2002.
