Number 163-91

To accept and assume as public highways the streets on Registered Registered Plan M-93

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has by resolution decided that all works constructed and installed in accordance with the subdivision agreement for Registered Plan M-93 be accepted and assumed;


AND WHEREAS Council has authorized the City Treasurer to release all securities held by the City in connection with the development of Registered Plan M-93;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient to accept and assume the streets on Registered Plan M-93 as part of the public highway system;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby accepted and assumed as part of the public highway system of the City of Brampton.
