THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 164-96

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan BR-4, being the property known municipally as 8 Nelson Street West

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subsection 5 of section 50 of the Planning Act, does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly Town of Brampton, County of Peel) being Part of the East Half of Lot 6, Concession 1 West of Hurontario Street, being Lot 83 and part of Lot 82 fronting on Hurontario Street, now known as Main Street North, Lot N fronting on George Street North, Lot 82, part of Lots 80 and 81 fronting on Nelson Street West according to a plan of the East half of Lot 6, Concession 1 West of Hurontario Street referred to as BR-4 designated as Parts 1 to 14, and 16 to 22, both inclusive, according to Reference Plan 43R-18369.

2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 9th day of September, 1996.
