BY-LAW

Number 166-86

To amend By-law 200-82
(26 Bramsteele Road)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by changing on Sheet 37 of Schedule A thereto the zoning designation of the land shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from INDUSTRIAL TWO (M2) to INDUSTRIAL TWO - SECTION 237 (M2-SECTION 237), such lands being part of Lot 1, Concession 2, E.H.S., in the geographic Township of Chinguacousy.

(2) by adding thereto the following section:

"237 The lands designated M2-SECTION 237 on Sheet 37 of Schedule A to this by-law:

237.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:

(1) a standard restaurant, and

(2) the purposes permitted in the M2 zone by section 32.1.1.

237.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:

(1) the gross commercial floor area of the standard restaurant shall not exceed 102 square metres, and


(2) a minimum of 50 parking spaces shall be provided on the site.

237.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and

restrictions of the M2 zone which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 237.2."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL,

this 23rd day of June, 1986.




