BY-LAW

Number 167-92


To further amend By-law 193-83
as amended

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby
ENACTS as follows:

1. Section (11), subsection (ix) of Part 5 of By-Law 193-83,
as amended is hereby repealed and the following is
substituted therefor.

ix) Where authorized by resolution of Council, the
commissioner shall cause to be erected, at
parking spaces controlled by parking meters, signs
bearing the international symbol for the
physically handicapped person. Where signs
bearing the international symbol for the
physically handicapped person are displayed at a
parking space controlled by a parking meter, no
person shall park any vehicle in said parking
space unless a valid identifying marker is
properly displayed upon the vehicle.
