BY-LAW

Number 168-2005

To authorize the purchase of Alloa Cemetery By the Corporation of the City of Brampton from The Alloa Cemetery Board of Trustees

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it appropriate to purchase the property commonly known as Alloa Cemetery, pursuant to a request to do so from the Alloa Cemetery Board of Trustees;

AND WHEREAS subsection 81(2)(a) of the Cemeteries Act (Revised), R.S.O. 1990, c. C.4 provides that the council of a municipality may pass by-laws authorizing the purchase of a cemetery or part thereof that is situated within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Alloa Cemetery Board of Trustees have agreed to transfer the Lands to the City of Brampton for \$2.00;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The purchase of the lands described as Part Lot 15, Concession 4 W.H.S. (former Township of Chinguacousy) as in CP58, City of Brampton, Region of Peel, subject to executions 94-01168 and 97-01602 (if enforceable) from the Alloa Cemetery Board of Trustees by The Corporation of the City of Brampton is hereby authorized;

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of June, 2005.
