BY-LAW

Number 169-2003

To authorize the execution of a management agreement with Credit Valley Conservation Authority for certain land in the Village of Churchville

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is advantageous to enter into a new agreement with Credit Valley Conservation Authority to allow the City's continued use of the parking lot adjacent to the Churchville Fire Station in exchange for the City's management of the parking lot property.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a management agreement with Credit Valley Conservation Authority for that part of Lot 15, Concession 3 West of Hurontario Street designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 43R-8951, for a term of 18 years with an option to terminate at the City's discretion, together with all other documents that, in the opinion of the City Solicitor, are necessary to give effect to the terms of the agreement, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, for the purpose of the City's continuing use of the parking lot adjacent to the Churchville Fire Station.

READ a **FIRST, SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 9th day of June, 2003.
