WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that part of Haggert Avenue as shown on Plan BR-35 be stopped up and closed, and certain parts sold to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this bylaw has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to Section 49 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 440, as amended) and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The part of Haggert Avenue on Plan BR-35 designated as parts 1 to 21 on Reference Plan 43R-17748 and parts 1 to 26 on Reference Plan 43R-17749 is hereby stopped up and closed.
- The sale of the parts of Haggert Avenue to the persons set out and for the prices set out in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby authorized.
- The granting or reservation of easements for existing utilities along, under or over the part of Haggert Avenue stopped up and closed by this by-law is hereby authorized.

- The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments necessary to give effect to the conveyances authorized by this bylaw.
- The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B forms part of this by-law. 5.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in open Council this 22nd day of AUGUST, 1990.

SCHEDULE B TO BY-LAW 174-90 Affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich

I, LEONARD J. MIKULICH, of the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, MAKE OATH AND SAY:

- 1. I am employed as Clerk and Director of Administration for The Corporation of the City of Brampton and as such, I have knowledge of the facts herein contained.
- 2. In accordance with section 301 of the Municipal Act, public notice of the intention to pass a by-law to stop up and close and authorize the sale of part of Haggert Avenue on Plan BR-35 was published in the Brampton Guardian on the following dates:

Wednesday, July 4, 1990, Wednesday, July 11, 1990, Wednesday, July 18, 1990, Wednesday, July 25, 1990.

- Municipality of Peel Act, a registered letter was sent from The Corporation of the City of Brampton to The Regional Municipality of Peel advising the Region of the City's intention to stop up and close part of Haggert Avenue on Plan BR-35. D.R. Billett, Director of Development Control for the Region, to whom the Region delegated approving authority for street closures, indicated to the City of Brampton that The Regional Municipality of Peel had no objection to the said stopping up and closure of part of Haggert Avenue on Plan BR-35.
- 4. The matter of the stopping up, closing and sale of part of Haggert Avenue on Plan BR-35 came before City Council at its meeting of the 22nd day of August, 1990. No persons applied to be heard in respect of this matter.
