To Appoint Fence-viewers For the
City of Brampton.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Brampton has by By-law declared that the Line Fences Act applies in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and advisable to appoint fence-viewers for the City of Brampton and to establish fees to be paid to such fence-viewers;

NOW THEREFORE The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the following persons be and are hereby appointed fence-viewers for the City of Brampton:

James Dalziel, 38 Woodward Ave., Brampton, Ontario.


Clarence Riesberry, 40 Centre Street, Brampton, Ontario.

Thomas Baker, 175 Central Park Drive, Brampton, Ontario.

2. For every day's work under the Act, each fence-viewer shall be paid a fee of \$10.00 (Ten dollars)

3. For every day's work under the Act, each fence-viewer shall be paid the sum of \$15.00 (Fifteen dollars) for expenses.
