To Appoint Fence-viewers For the City of Brampton.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Brampton has by By-law declared that the Line Fences Act applies in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and advisable to appoint fence-viewers for the City of Brampton and to establish fees to be paid to such fence-viewers;

NOW THEREFORE The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the following persons be and are hereby appointed fence-viewers for the City of Brampton:

 James Dalziel, 38 Woodward Ave., Brampton, Ontario.

 Clarence Riesberry, 40 Centre Street, Brampton, Ontario.

 Thomas Baker, 175 Central Park Drive, Brampton, Ontario.
- 2. For every day's work under the Act, each fence viewer shall be paid a fee of \$10.00 (Ten dollars)
- 3. For every day's work under the Act, each fence-viewer shall be paid the sum of \$15.00 (Fifteen dollars) for expenses.
