BY-LAW

Number 178-96

To authorize the expropriation
of part of Lot 13, Concession 1
West of Hurontario Street for
public highway purposes

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as expropriating authority, has determined that it is in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to expropriate the lands described in this by-law for public highway purposes, namely the widening of Sandalwood Parkway West.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The expropriation of the lands described as part of the east half of Lot 13, Concession 1 West of Hurontario Street in the City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly Township of Chinguacousy, County of Peel) designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 43R-21645 is hereby authorized. The purpose for which the lands are to be expropriated is for public highway purposes, namely the widening of Sandalwood Parkway West.
2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to sign all notices and advertisements on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as may be required by the Expropriations Act in order to effect the expropriation of the lands described in this by-law.
