Number 179-82

To change a certain street name
(Kensington Road, part of Lot 5,
Concession 4, E.H.S.)

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of
Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of part of Kensington
Road;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law
has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the
Brampton Guardian and the Daily Times, two newspapers having
general circulation in the City of Brampton;


AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed
that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied
to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City
of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of the part of the street known as "Kensington
Road" which is described in Schedule A attached hereto,
is changed to "Peel Centre Drive".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open
Council this 13th day of September, 1982.
