# BY-LAW

Number 179-2010

To prevent the application of part lot control to  
part of Registered Plan 43M - 1805

**WHEREAS** subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

**AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS**, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

**NOW THEREFORE**, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 2, 3, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21 inclusive on Registered Plan 43M-1805.

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on May 26, 2013.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 2010.
