To amend By-law 200-82

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(a) by deleting from SECTION 5.0, DEFINITIONS, thereof, the definition for <u>SCHOOL</u>, <u>COMMERCIAL</u> and substituting therefor the following definition:

"<u>SCHOOL, COMMERCIAL, TECHNICAL OR RECREATIONAL</u> shall mean a building or place where training in language skills, secretarial skills or other trade skills, or training in sports, dance or other recreational skills, is provided for compensation."

(b) by deleting from Section 20.3, <u>Parking Spaces</u>, thereof, the parking requirement for "Commercial or Technical School" and substituting therefor the following parking requirement:

"Commercial, Technical or Recreational School 4 parking spaces for each teaching classroom or equivalent facility, or 1 space for each 20 square metres of gross commercial floor area or portion thereof, whichever is greater." (c) by renumbering sections 30.6(4) and (5) to sections 30.6(5) and (6), respectively and adding to Section 30.6, <u>Commercial Uses in Industrial Zones</u>, thereof, the following section 30.6(4):

30.6 "(4) A commercial, technical or recreational school;"

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 26th day of June 1989.
