# **BY-LAW**

Zoning By-Law 270-2004.

Number 181-2007

To amend By-Law 276-2004, as amended, an Interim Control By-Law Applicable to Part of the Area Subject to

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-Law 276-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following:
  - 1.9 Notwithstanding Section 1, the lands known municipally as 168 Kennedy Road South, described as Part of Lot 2, Concession 2, E.H.S. and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption from Interim Control By-Law 263-2005 as amended by By-laws 316-2005, 4-2007 and181-2007", as outlined on Schedule A to By-law 276-2004, as amended, permits a day care use restricted to Unit C2 to a maximum size of 2,000 square feet.
- 2. Schedule A to By-law 276-2004 as amended, is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this By-Law.


