To authorize an application to The Regional Municipality of Peel for the issuance of debentures in the amount of \$14,625,000 on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton

WHEREAS section 123 of the <u>Municipal Act</u> authorizes a municipal council to borrow money for the purposes of the municipal corporation;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has obtained the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board under section 64 of the Ontario Municipal Board Act for the projects descibed in Schedule A to this by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 94 of the <u>Regional Municipality of</u>
<u>Peel Act</u> permits The Regional Municipality of Peel to borrow money for the purposes of any area municipality and to issue debentures therefor;

AND WHEREAS section 1(a) of the <u>Regional Municipality of</u>
<u>Peel Act</u> defines "area municipality" so as to include The
Corporation of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to request, on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, the Council of The Regional Municipality of Peel to pass a by-law authorizing the issue and sale of debentures in the total amount of \$14,625,000 for the purpose of financing the projects described in Schedule A to this by-law, in accordance with the orders of the Ontario Municipal Board listed in Schedule A to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of August 1990.
