A by-law to change the name of

Octal Road on Registered Plan

43M-469

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the name of a certain street in Registered Plan 43M-469;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS Council has heard all persons who claim that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of the street shown as "Digital Road" on Registered Plan 43M-469 (which was changed to "Octal Road" by By-law 1-83) and which is described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, is changed to "Automatic Road".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL this 11th day of July, 1983.
