Number 184-77

Being a By-law to Amend By-law
Numbers 808, 818 and 825 of the
former Township of Toronto Gore

The Council of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. That By-law Number 93-77 be amended by adding after Section 3 a new Section 3A to read as follows:


"3A. That for the Estate Residential (ER) Zone of this By-law, there shall be a minimum rear yard (depth) of twenty-five (25) feet for all lots abutting on the Flood Plain Zone (F), as shown on Schedule 'A' hereto attached. No building, including an accessory building, shall be erected within the rear yard."

2. That this By-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.
