

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 184-2003

To amend By-law Number 77-73, being a part lot control by-law, to delete certain lands

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is the successor to The Corporation of the Township of Chinguacousy pursuant to the provisions of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act.

AND WHEREAS Menkes Brampton II Holdings Inc. has applied to The Corporation of the City of Brampton for site plan approval for a development on Part of Blocks A & V, Plan 977 designated as Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 43R-25437;

AND WHEREAS the said lands are currently exempted from part lot control by Township of Chinguacousy By-Law 77-73.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary for implementation of the development proposal that the lands described as Part of Blocks A & V, Plan 977 designated as Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 43R-25437 be deleted from By-Law 77-73;

AND WHEREAS section 50(7.5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended permits Council by by-law, to amend any part lot control exemption by-law to delete part of the land described in it;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 77-73 of the former Township of Chinguacousy is hereby amended by deleting the lands described as Part of Blocks A & V, Plan 977 designated as Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 43R-25437 from Schedule to the by-law

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 23rd day of June, 2003.
