
To authorize the execution of a farm lease
to Alvista Farms (A. Thompson et al).
1985 Bovaird Drive West

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to enter into a lease with Alvista Farms (A. Thompson et al) to allow farming on certain City owned lands;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a lease agreement between the City of Brampton (Landlord) and Alvista Farms (A. Thompson et al) (Tenant) at full market rent for a renewable, one-year term, for the use of about forty acres of vacant land for farming at 1985 Bovaird Drive West, as illustrated on the sketch attached hereto as Schedule A, on terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Community Services and in a form approved by the City Solicitor, together with all other documents that, in the opinion of the City Solicitor, are necessary to give effect to the terms of the lease agreement.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of June, 2005.
