

To amend By-Law 312-2005, An Interim Control By-Law Applicable to Part of the Area Subject to Zoning By-Law 270-2004.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. By-Law 312-2005 is amended by adding the following:
 5. Notwithstanding Section 1, the lands known municipally as 8 Bramwin Court, described as Part of Lot 2, Concession 6, E.H.S. and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption from Interim Control By-Law 312-2005", as amended by By-law 185-2006, outlined on Schedule A to this by-law may permit a waste processing station with no outdoor storage.
2. Schedule A-2 to By-Law 312-2005 is deleted and replaced with Schedule A-2 attached to this By-Law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 12 day of JUNE 2006.

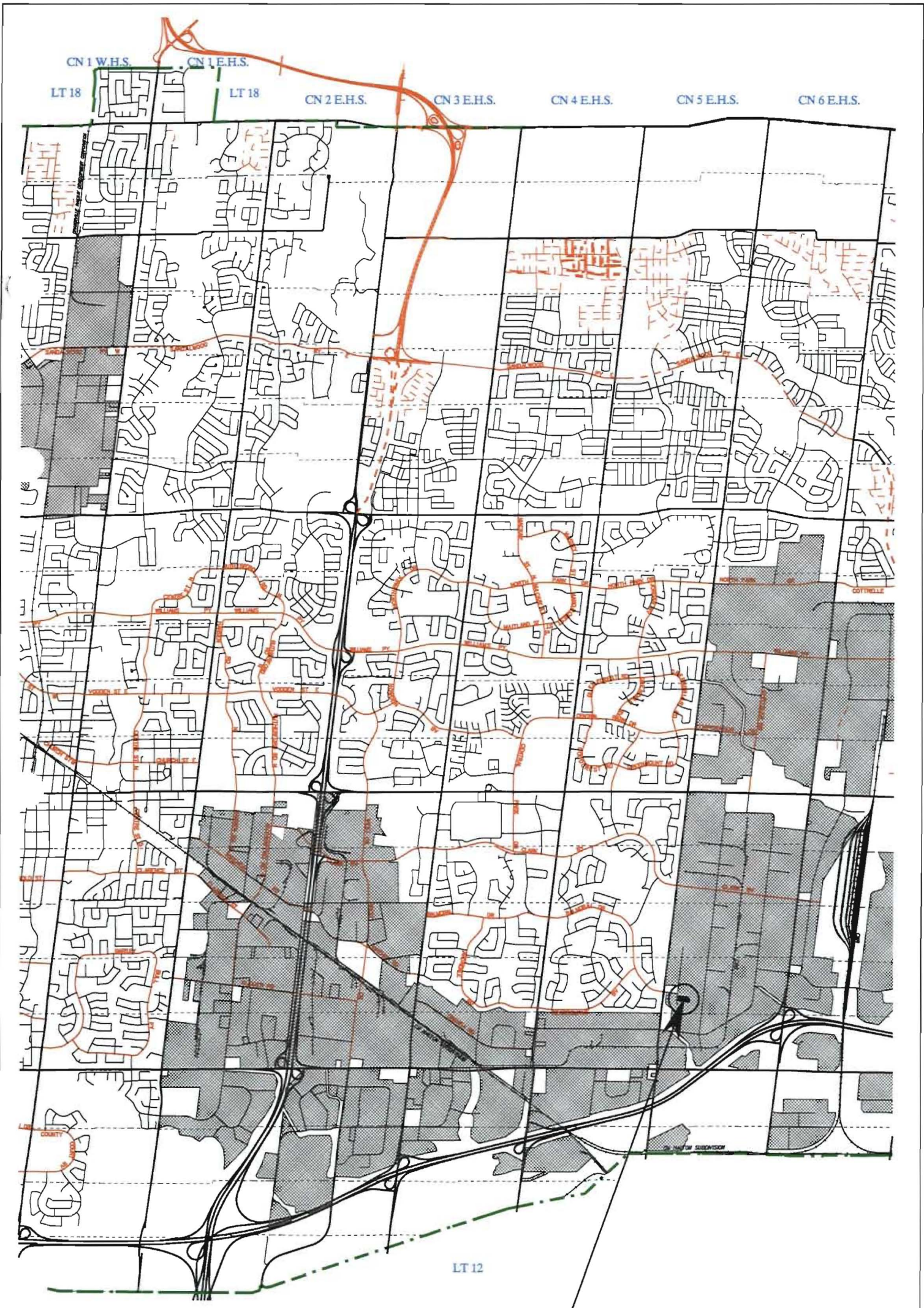
