

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

185-2008 Number

To declare surplus and authorize the Transfer of fee simple interest over Part of Lot 5, Concession 10 ND, designated Parts 26 and 50 on Plan 43R-32167, and the Transfer of Easement over Part of Lot 5, Concession 10 ND, designated as Part 74 on Plan 43R-32167 and to repeal By-Law No. 158-2008

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a transfer of fee simple interest in the lands for right of way purposes described as being Part of Lot 5, Concession 10 ND, designated as Parts 26 and 50 on Plan 43R-32167 (the "Fee Simple Lands") and a transfer of easement for sanitary sewer purposes over Part of Lot 5, Concession 10 ND, designated as Part 74 on Plan 43R-32167 and (the "Easement Lands") are to be conveyed to The Regional Municipality of Peel (the "Region").

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by By-Law No. 98-2005 have been followed:

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby **ENACTS** as follows:

- The transfer of the Fee Simple Lands and the transfer of easement over 1. the Easement Lands for nominal consideration in favour of the Region is hereby authorized;
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to effect the transfers of the Fee Simple Lands and the transfer of easement over the Easement Lands;
- By-Law No. 158-2008 is hereby repealed.
