



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 186-851

To amend By-law 861 (part of Lots 1 and 2, Concession 6, E.H.S., (Chinguacousy))

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A of By-law 861, as amended, is hereby amended by changing the zoning classification of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL CLASS 1 (A1) to INDUSTRIAL SELECT 5 - SECTION 448 (M5 - SECTION 448) and CONSERVATION AND GREENBELT (G).
2. Schedule A to this by-law is hereby attached to By-law 861 as part of Schedule A, and forms part of By-law 861.
3. By-law 861, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following section:

"448 The lands designated M5 - Section 448 on Schedule A to this by-law:

448.1.1 shall only be used for:

(a) the purposes permitted in a M5 zone

(b) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes


448.1.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:

(a) no storage shall be permitted outside a building in an area located closer than 25 metres to the east limit of Torbram Road

448.1.3 shall also be subject to the restrictions and requirements relating to the M5 zone which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 429.1.2."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and Passed in Open Council.

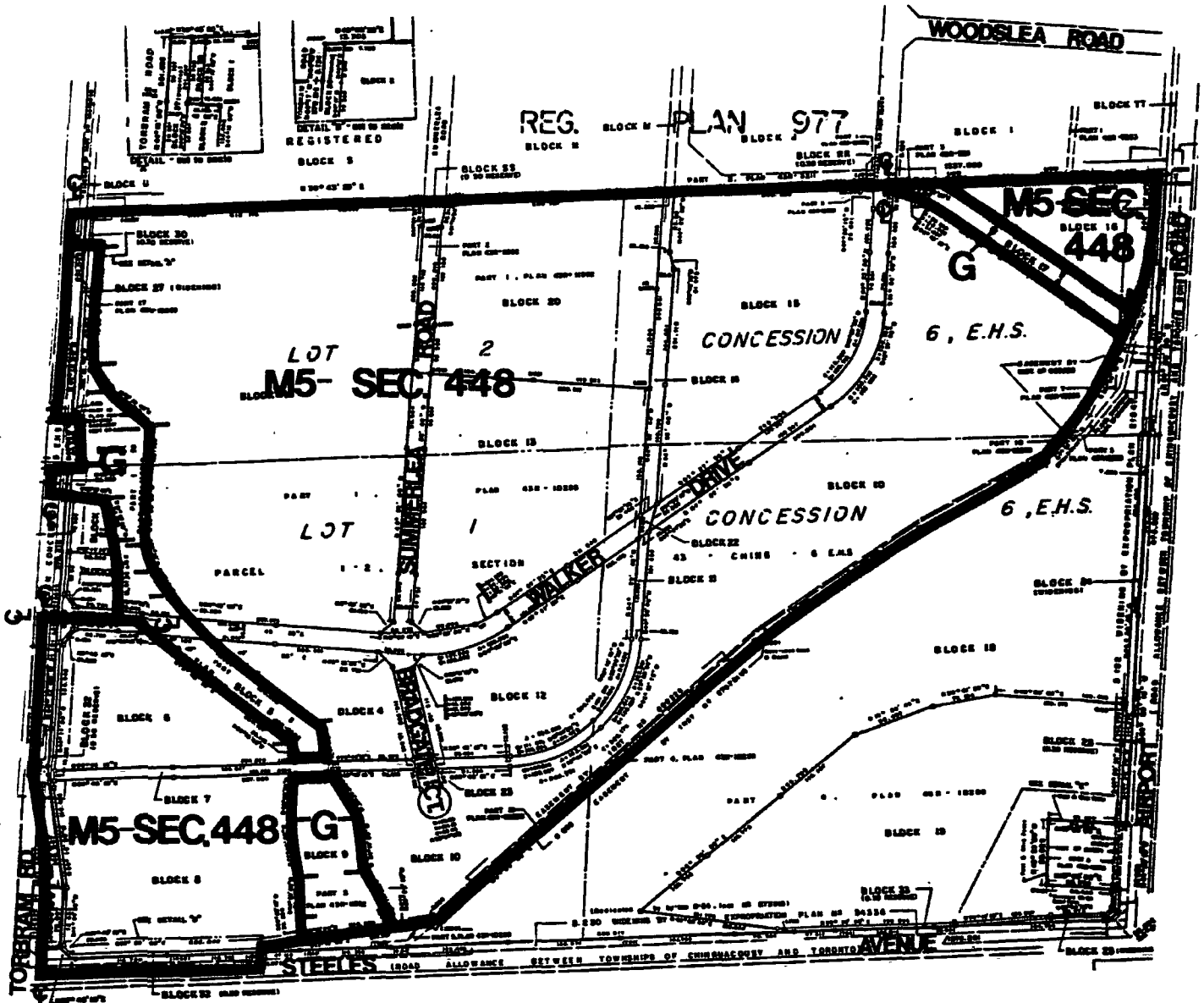
