BY-LAW

Number 186-2000

A by-law to provide for early voting on voting day and reduced hours of voting in institutions and retirement homes and to repeal By-law 130-97

WHEREAS Section 46(2) of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law providing that specified voting places shall be open on voting day at a specified time before 10:00 a.m.;

AND WHEREAS Section 46(3) of the aforesaid Act provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law with respect to reduced voting hours in voting places in retirement homes or those institutions as defined in Section 45(7) of the said Act, where the voting place is only for the use of the residents;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:


1. Voting shall be held at the locations and times as noted below, with respect to the Municipal Election to be held November 13, 2000:

Woodhall Park	11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
William Osler Health Centre	
Brampton Memorial Hospital Campus	10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Tullamore Nursing Home	2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Southbrook Lodge	9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.


2. By-law 130-97 is hereby repealed.
