### THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 187-75

To prescribe speed limits on portions of certain highways.

WHEREAS Section 82, Subsection 5 of The Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 202, as amended permits The Council of a City to prescribe a higher rate of speed for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion of a highway under it's jurisdiction than is prescribed by subsection 1 of said Section 8;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prescribe such rate of speed for motor vehicles driven on certain highways or portions thereof;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Where any highway or portion of highway set out in Schedule "A" hereto is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be 35 miles per hour.
- 2. Where any highway or portion of highway set out in Schedule "B" hereto is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be 40 miles per hour.
- 3. Where any highway or portion of highway set out in Schedule "C" hereto is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be 50 miles per hour.
- 4. The penalties provided in Subsection 16 of Section 82 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this By-law.
- 5.(a) Subject to subsection (b) this By-law shall not become effective until approved by The Regional Municipality of Peel.

- (b) That part of the By-law regulating speed on Main Street South, which is designated as a connecting link under the Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, shall not become effective until approved by The Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
- 6. That By-laws Number 42-74, 3-75 and 152-75 are hereby repealed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 6th day of October, 1975.
