Number 188-83 To change certain street names

(Second Line East)

WHEREAS paragraph 105 of section 210 of the <u>Municipal</u> <u>Act</u> (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, as amended) permits the council of a local municipality to pass by-laws changing the names of public highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the names of certain public highways;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the Daily Times, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 The name of the street known as "Second Line East" (also known as Heart Lake Road), being the road allowance between Concession 2 and 3, East of Hurontario Street, from the southerly boundary of

the City of Brampton as established by subsection 2(4) of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 440, as amended) to the easterly limit of Highway Number 410, is changed to and is to be known as part of "Tomken Road".


The street name change effected by section 1 to this 2. by-law is shown on the map attached as Schedule A hereto.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this ^{11th} day of July , 1983.


