
NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:


- (1) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 39-74 be amended by the addition thereto of the following under the appropriate columns thereof.

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>FACING TRAFFIC</u>
Braemar Drive at Northerly Intersection of Beechwood Crescent	Northbound on Braemar Drive
Braemar Drive at Northerly Intersection of Beechwood Crescent	Southbound on Braemar Drive
Braemar Drive at Southerly Intersection of Burnham Crescent	Northbound on Braemar Drive
Braemar Drive at Southerly Intersection of Burnham Crescent	Southbound on Braemar Drive


- (2) The provisions of this By-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Corporation of The Regional Municipality of Peel.
