BY-LAW

Number 193-88

To amend By-law 861, (part of Lot 11, Concession 1, E.H.S., geographic Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 861, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-law 169-86, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting therefrom section 480.1.1, and substituting therefor:

"480.1.1 shall only be used for the following purposes:

- (1) an animal hospital;
- (2) a bank, trust company or financial institution;
- (3) retail stores;
- (4) a real estate office;
- (5) a travel agency;
- (6) a hair dresser, and
- (7) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL,

this 12th day of September 1988.


