the sale of part of Johnston Avenue

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of
The Corporation of the City of Brampton that part of Johnston
Avenue be stopped up and closed and sold to the owners of the
abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this by-law
has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in
The Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice
to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 49
of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 440,
as amended) and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated
that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has
heard in person, or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all
persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected
by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the
City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Part of Johnston Avenue, more particularly described
in Schedule A attached to this by-law be and the same
is hereby stopped up and closed.

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
