To amend Development Charges By-law No. 235-91

WHEREAS By-law No. 235-91 which was passed and came into force on the 28th day of October, 1991 pursuant to the provisions of the <u>Development Charges Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c.D9 (the "Act"), imposed development charges on all residential and non-residential land uses for a term not to exceed five (5) years from the date of its coming into force;

AND WHEREAS the Council wishes to amend By-law No. 235-91 to delete the provision in the By-law which provides for the term of the By-law;

AND WHEREAS Council gave notice to the public and held a public meeting pursuant to sections 4 and 7 of the Act on the 16th day of October, 1996, prior to and at which sufficient information was made available to the public and the Council heard comments and representations from all persons who applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:

1. By-law 235-91 is amended by deleting therefrom section 19.

2. This by-law comes into force and takes effect on the 16th day of October, 1996.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TIME and passed in Open Council this 16th day of October, 1996.
