## **BY-LAW**

To designate Blocks 4 and 5, Registered Plan 43M-987 pursuant to Section 50(11) of the Planning Act

WHEREAS Brita (Canada) Inc. has applied to The Corporation of the City of Brampton for site plan approval for a development on Blocks 4 and 5, Registered Plan 43M-987;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary for implementation of the development proposal that Blocks 4 and 5, Registered Plan 43M-987, be merged as one parcel of land;

AND WHEREAS section 50(4) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended permits Council by by-law, to designate any plan of subdivision, or part thereof, that has been registered for eight years or more, which shall be deemed not to be a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of subsection 50(3) of the Planning Act;

AND WHEREAS Registered Plan 43M-987 was registered on August 29, 1990;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands described as Blocks 4 and 5, Registered Plan 43M-987, are hereby designated pursuant to subsection 50(4) of the <u>Planning Act</u> and are deemed not to be part of a registered plan of subdivision for the purposes of subsection 50(3) of the <u>Planning Act</u>.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 14th day of September, 1998.
