

## **BY-LAW**

Number	200-77	

Being a By-law to amend By-law Number 117-76.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it desirable to amend The Sign By-law, being By-law Number 117-76;

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts that By-law Number 117-76 of the City of Brampton is hereby amended as follows:

1. By-law Number 117-76 is hereby amended by adding the following Section:

SECTION 10a NON-CONFORMING COMMERCIAL USES Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this By-law relating to zoned areas, signs shall be permitted on Commercial properties which are legal nonconforming uses and on all other properties being used for Commercial purposes where the commercial use commenced under a building permit and/or occupancy permit issued by the City of Brampton or any other municipality previously having jurisdiction over lands now within the City of Brampton, provided that any such sign shall comply with the provisions of Section 6.2 of this By-law as though the said lands were zoned Commercial and provided that no signs with lights, either flashing or continuous, shall be permitted within fifty (50) feet of the nearest property line of any

existing Residential property and no other signs shall be permitted within ten (10) feet of the nearest property line of any existing Residential property.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and finally passed in OPEN COUNCIL this 22nd day of August , 1977.
