BY-LAW NUMBER 203-75

Being a By-law to stop up and
close and authorize the sale
of part of Lowes Avenue.

WHEREAS the City of Brampton has assumed the said street as a
public highway, and;


WHEREAS because of the nature of the development on the lands
abutting, the City of Brampton now deems it desirable that a
certain part of Lowes Avenue be stopped up, closed and sold
to the abutting owners;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of
Brampton ENACTS as follows;

- (1) That that part of Lowes Avenue as shown on a Plan
registered in the Registry Office for the Registry
Division of Peel as D-12, more particularly
described as Parts 2 and 3 on Reference Plan 43R-3454,
deposited within the said Registry Office, be and the
same is hereby stopped up and closed
- (2) That the sale of the land stopped up and closed
by paragraph 1 of this By-law be and the same is
hereby authorized for the sum of \$2.00
- (3) That the said lands stopped up and closed by
paragraph 1 of this By-law be offered first to
the abutting owners


