BY-LAW

204–90 Number

To amend By-law 139-84 (part of Lot 15, Concession 4, E.H.S. geographic Township of Toronto)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 139-84, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing, on Sheet 10 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from INDUSTRIAL ONE-SECTION 584 (M1-SECTION 584) to INDUSTRIAL ONE-SECTION 691 (M1-SECTION 691), such lands being part of Lot 15, Concession 4, E.H.S. in the geographic Township of Toronto;
 - (2) by deleting therefrom Section 584, and substituting therefor the following:
 - "691 The lands designated M1-SECTION 691 on Sheet 10 of Schedule A to this By-law
 - 691.1 shall be used only for those purposes permitted by section 30.7 and section 31.1.1 of this by-law
 - 691.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - the gross commercial floor area used for a dining room restaurant shall not exceed 364 square metres;
 - (2) the gross commercial floor area used for a community club shall not exceed 360 square metres;

(3) an adult entertainment parlour shall not be permitted in connection with or accessory to a dining room restaurant or a community club. 691.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the M1 zone and all of the general provisions of this by-law, which are not in conflict with the ones set out in Section 691.2."
