(1) by changing on Schedule A thereto of the By-law, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A attached to this by-law



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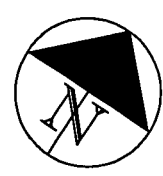


LEGEND



