Plan M-287


WHEREAS By-law 245-80 enacted pursuant to subsection 29(5) of The Planning Act (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 379, as amended), provided that subsection 29(4) of The Planning Act did not apply to those lands within Registered Plan M-287 which are described in Schedule A to this by-law, in order that certain lots could be redivided;


AND WHEREAS such redivision has now been completed, and part lot control should once again be applied to these lands;
