To amend By-law 93-93
for the installation of ALL WAY STOPS
at Fernforest Drive and Peter Robertson Boulevard
and at Morton Way and Morton Way

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 93-93, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

(1) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule III thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 BETWEEN
Fernforest Drive	The south limit of Sandalwood Parkway East and the north limit of Bovaird Drive
Morton Way	The north limit of Plaxton Gate and the west limit of Talon Gate

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule III thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 HIGHWAY	COLUMN 2 BETWEEN
Fernforest Drive	The south limit of Sandalwood Parkway East and the south limit of Bobcat Street
Fernforest Drive	The north limit of Homewood Street/Softneedle Avenue and the north limit of Bovaird Drive

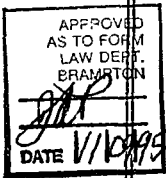
(3) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule IV thereto the following items:



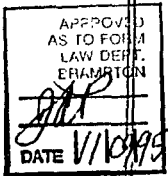


